## Core Competency

Global QHSE programs developing  
Managed - Across "ALL" job skills  
Multiple levels – Identified & Tested  
Specific time review periods

**How do we support Local NON Global Members?**

## Safety

Local – environment, site specific, experience level, Manageable

Regional – How do we transfer our LOCAL standard Regionally.

Global – QHSE programs developing global

## **Do they work – Are they Successful?**

What do the numbers say?

How many Unplanned events take place?

What is the Unplanned cost?

## **Safety**

Is two years (and counting) for an Offshore Service Team without a recordable or LTA an indication of the training working?

What is the measure of success?

**Zero = Life**

# Do They Need Same Attention?

## **Inexperienced vs Seasoned**

**Inexperienced** – Colour of Hardhat - Rig Site

(what do we do in the office, Shop,  
Transport. Shore Base / Yard)

VS

**Seasoned** – Assume because Hardhat is not specific colour.

## **Young vs Old**

**Young** - getting the message from start  
(Needs knowledge to recognize hazards)

VS

**Old** - not ingrained, carrying history  
(needs Discipline to STOP!)

**Each person, each job skill needs to be managed,  
reviewed, reassessed, retrained and allowed to progress**

**Is the Industry mature enough to set a  
standard minimum entrant certificate  
Globally, Regionally, Locally?**

**It does in some Regions!**

Does **Safety Training**  
need to be a part of the  
**Competition?**

**Safety has no price!**
