Contractor Standards Released

- Contractor Standards Released
 - December 2007 by the Department of Mines and Energy – Queensland
 - Result of Recommendations from Inquest into Rig Fatality February 2003.



Work up to to Standards Compliance

- Work Up
- Identify the requirements of the Standards
- Identify Resources Required to Comply
- Draft Plan in place October 2008
- Digest the requirements of the Standards
- Accredited Qualifications for all Rig Positions
- Employed Training Coordinator October 2007
 - Commenced RPL to Certificate III of all Toolpushers and drillers May 2008
- Registered Training Organisations (RTO) accredited for the required qualifications
 - No Public Provider accredited in QLD
- Trainers Qualified to Train and Assess the required Qualifications



Standards Compliance

- Implemented Training Plan for Compliance November 2008
- Assist RTO to gain Registration Jan 09
- Commenced Training and RPL Program
- Tabled Plan with Inspectorate Oil & Gas
 - Verbal approval received
- All rig employees issued Training Plans for current positions
- Employed Training Coordinator - Production - Commence writing Cert II Resources
- Employed Qualified Trainers to work with Content Experts Dec 08
- Assisted RTO with Registration to Cert III
 - RTO registration received Mar 09 to Cert III
 - RTO Scope extended to Diploma in Jul 09
 - Trainers start using first five validated units resources for Cert II O & G Feb 09
 - Training Coordinator facilitating RPL for Supervisors / Toolpushers Mar 09



Current Position

- Current Position in regards to the Standards
 - All Rig Supervisors and Toolpusher RPL completed to Diploma through TAFE
 - All Rig Crew Members working under qualified supervisors
 - Training Plans in place for all
 - All crew members up to Derrickman completed first 11 units of Certificate II O & G
- Training Resources and Assessment Tool for first 12 Units of Competency written and validated by TAFE – Nov 09
- RPL Program running for Derrickmen and Drillers for Cert IV
- RPL Program running for new senior employees to Diploma

- Target Position for end 2010
 - Training Plans changed over to the new RII09 package.
 - Training & Assessment Resources changed over to the RII09 package and re-validated through TAFE Qld
 - Training & Assessment Resources developed for Certificate III under the new RIISC package and validated through TAFE QLD
 - Training, Assessment and RPL programs to continue.
 - Maintenance Mode for Churn rate.
